All Students K-6

Proper gym clothes according to handbook regulations: tee shirts, loose fitting sweat pants, or shorts to the knee (No yoga pants). **Back pack** (large enough to hold a 10x13 envelope), **Bible** (to be left at school), **2 large boxes of tissues, 2 large containers of Disinfecting Wipes, and 2 rolls of paper towels.**

Kindergarten

Lunchbox (send only unbreakable containers)
Many glue sticks (about 12-15 per student)
1 box Crayola crayons
1 box colored pencils (optional)
1 pair child's fiskar scissors (rounded tip)
1 doz. #2 pencils (may also send pencil top erasers)
NO mechanical pencils
1 large eraser (pink pearl)
1 pencil box
1 small rug, mat, or blanket for rest time
Extra set of clothes
1 Folder
Plastic closing pencil/art supply box to fit into their desk

Grades 1 & 2

Lunchbox (send only unbreakable containers)
1 bottle Elmer's white glue & 15 glue sticks
1 box Crayola crayons (24 count)
1 pair **child** scissors (1st grade) and pointed scissors (2nd grade)
1 box of 24 #2 pencils (to be left at school)
1 12" ruler w/metric and standard rule to 1/16th (no folding rulers or bendables & prefer ruler where the measurements start at the very end)
2 pencil boxes-1 for pencils & 1 for art supplies (that will fit into a desk)
10 pk of washable markers
4 dry erase markers
P.E. clothes (see dress code)
1 package fine point markers
1 package colored pencils
1 Book cover for a hardcover book (2nd grade only), **not** the stick-on-kind
1 large pink eraser/several pencil top erasers
2 large pocket folders with 2 pockets (not w/clasps)
1 Notebook (70 sheets – 1 subject notebook)
