All Students K-6

Back pack (large enough to hold a 10x13 envelope), Bible (to be left at school), 2 large boxes of tissues, 2 large containers of Disinfecting Wipes, and 1 roll of paper towels. **Proper gym clothes**** (see below)

Kindergarten

Lunchbox (send only unbreakable containers)
Many glue sticks (about 12-15 per student)
1 box Crayola crayons
1 box colored pencils (optional)
1 pair child's Fiskars scissors (rounded tip)
1 doz. #2 pencils (may also send pencil top erasers)
NO mechanical pencils
1 large eraser (pink pearl)
1 pencil box
1 small rug, mat, or blanket for rest time
Extra set of clothes
1 Folder with pockets
Plastic closing pencil/art supply box to fit into their desk
1 12" ruler

Grades 1 & 2

Lunchbox (send only unbreakable containers)
1 bottle Elmer's white glue & 10 glue sticks
1 box Crayola crayons (24 count)
1 pair **child** scissors (1st grade) or pointed scissors (2nd grade)
1 box of 24 #2 pencils (to be left at school)
1 12" ruler w/metric and standard rule to 1/16th (no bendable or folding rulers & we prefer rulers where the measurements start at the very end)
2 pencil boxes-1 for pencils & 1 for art supplies (that will fit into a desk)
2 dry erase markers
1 package fine point or washable markers
1 package colored pencils
1 Book cover for a hardcover book (2nd grade only), **not** stick-on
1 large pink eraser/several pencil top erasers
1 large pocket folders with 2 pockets (not w/clasps)
1 Notebook (70 sheets – 1 subject notebook)

****Proper gym clothes** according to the handbook regulations: high collar tee shirts (**No scoop or V-necks permitted**), shorts to the knee or loose fitting sweat pants (**No yoga pants**).
