## All Students 7-12

**9th-12<sup>th</sup> grades**- Graphing (recommended TI-83 or higher) Graphing calculators are becoming requirements in most mathematic courses for college-bound students. Beginning with freshman, all high school BBKA students are **REQUIRED** to have such a calculator.
